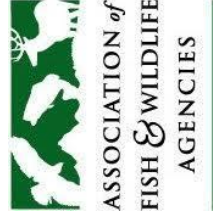

- Turtles are reptiles.
- The scales on turtle's shells are made of keratin like your fingernails.
- Not all turtles are tortoises.
- The largest turtle in the world is the leatherback sea turtle.
- The smallest turtle in North America is the bog turtle.
- Jonathan, a Seychelles giant tortoise (*Aldabrachelys gigantea hololissa*), is the oldest turtle in the world. He turned 190 in 2022.

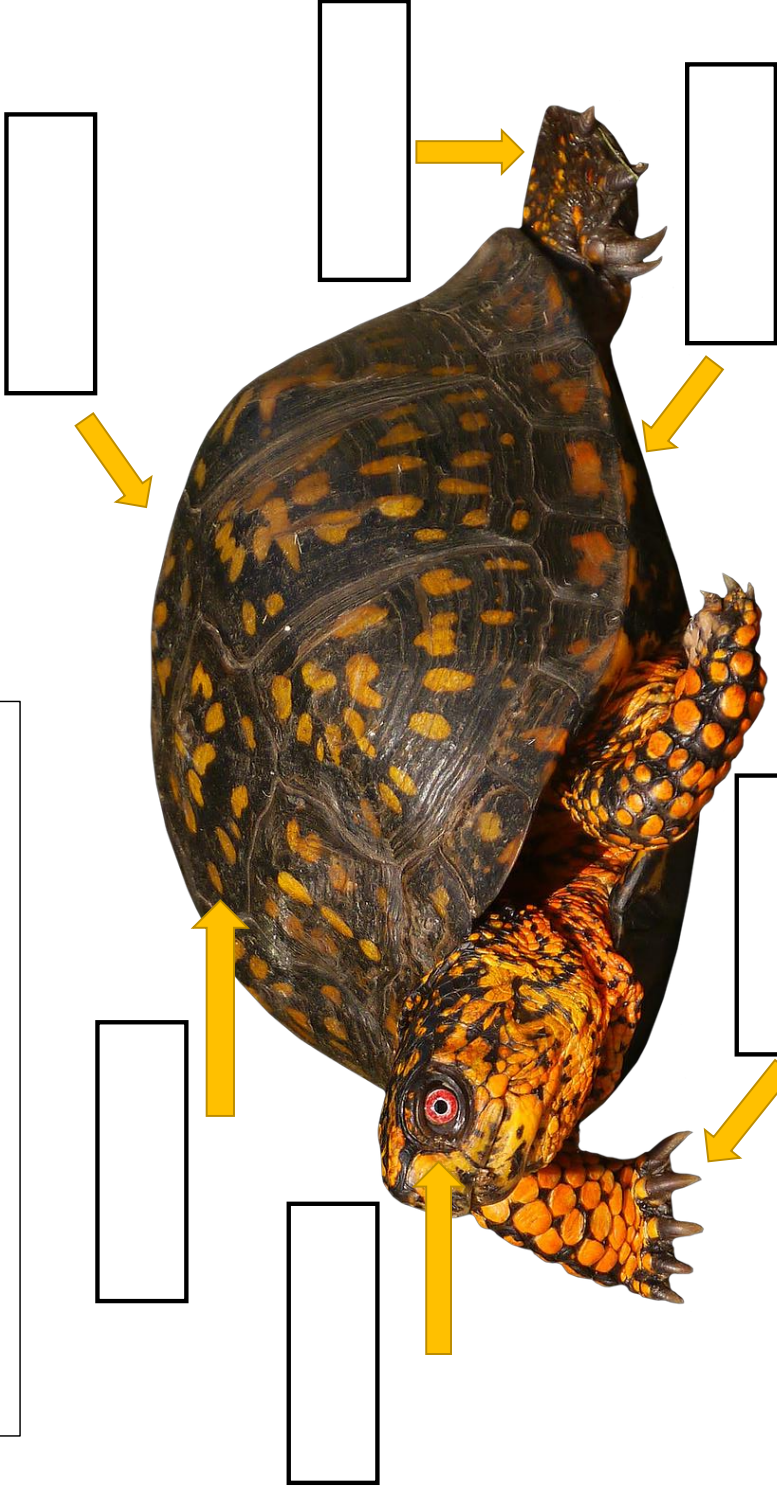

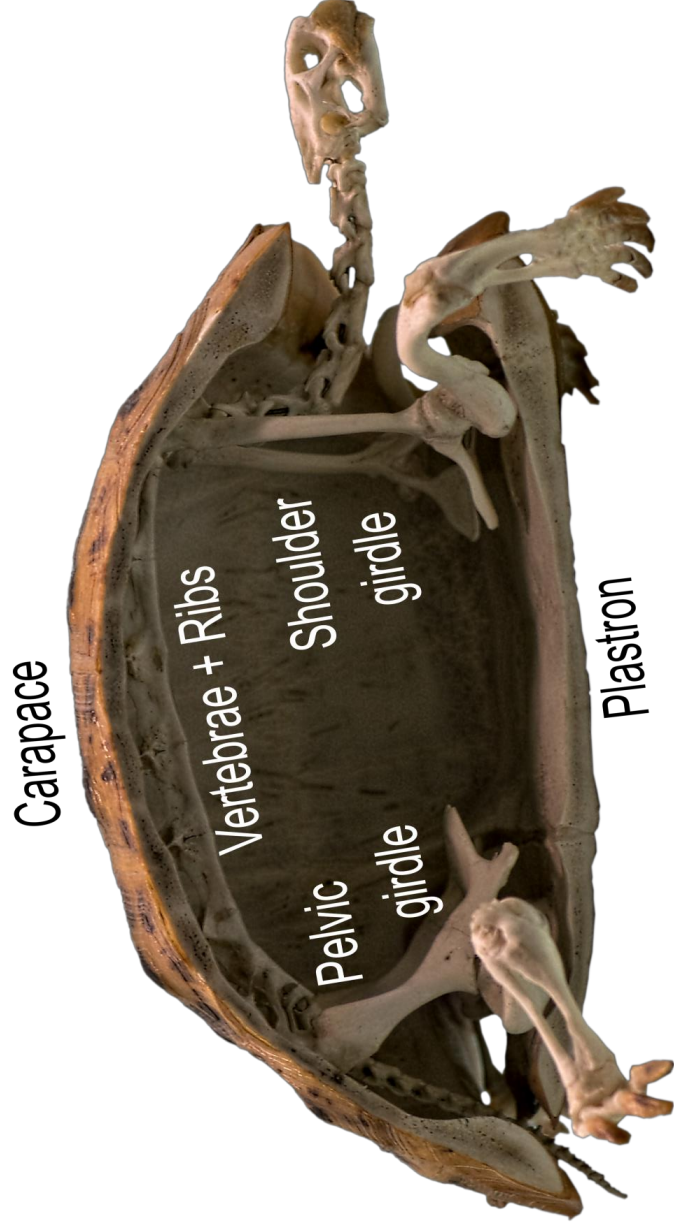

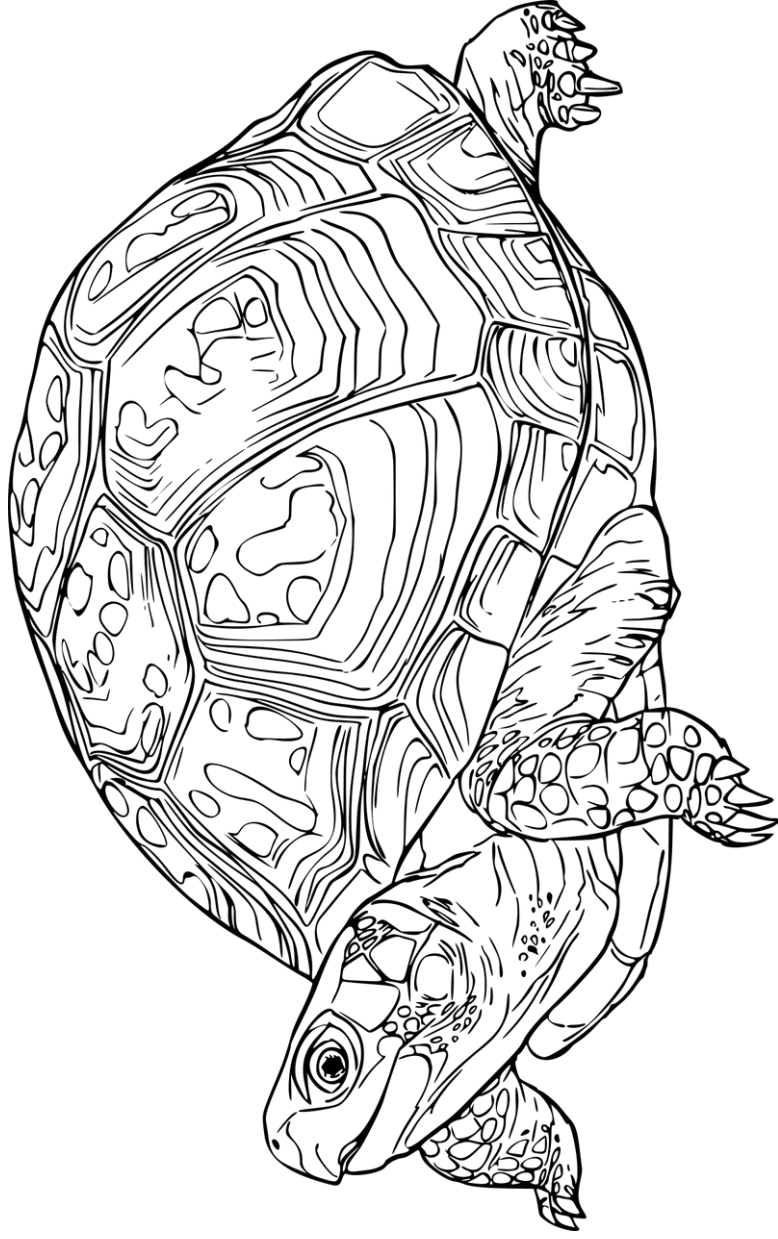

Turtle Anatomy Snacks

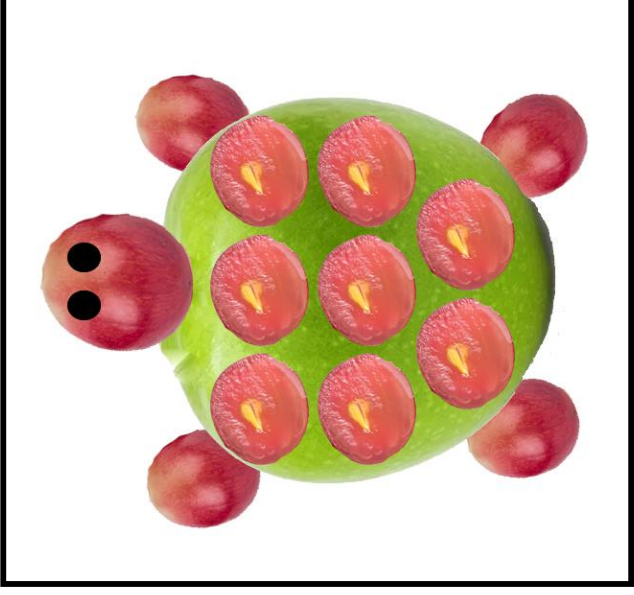
Learn about the parts of a turtle and have fun, too!

Cool Turtle Spotlight

Despite its name, the **wood turtle** splits its time between forests and streams.

The wood turtle's shell looks like it has carved wood pyramids on top.

The wood turtle does a “worm stomp” after rain to get worms to come to the soil surface.

It takes wood turtles up to 14 years to breed!

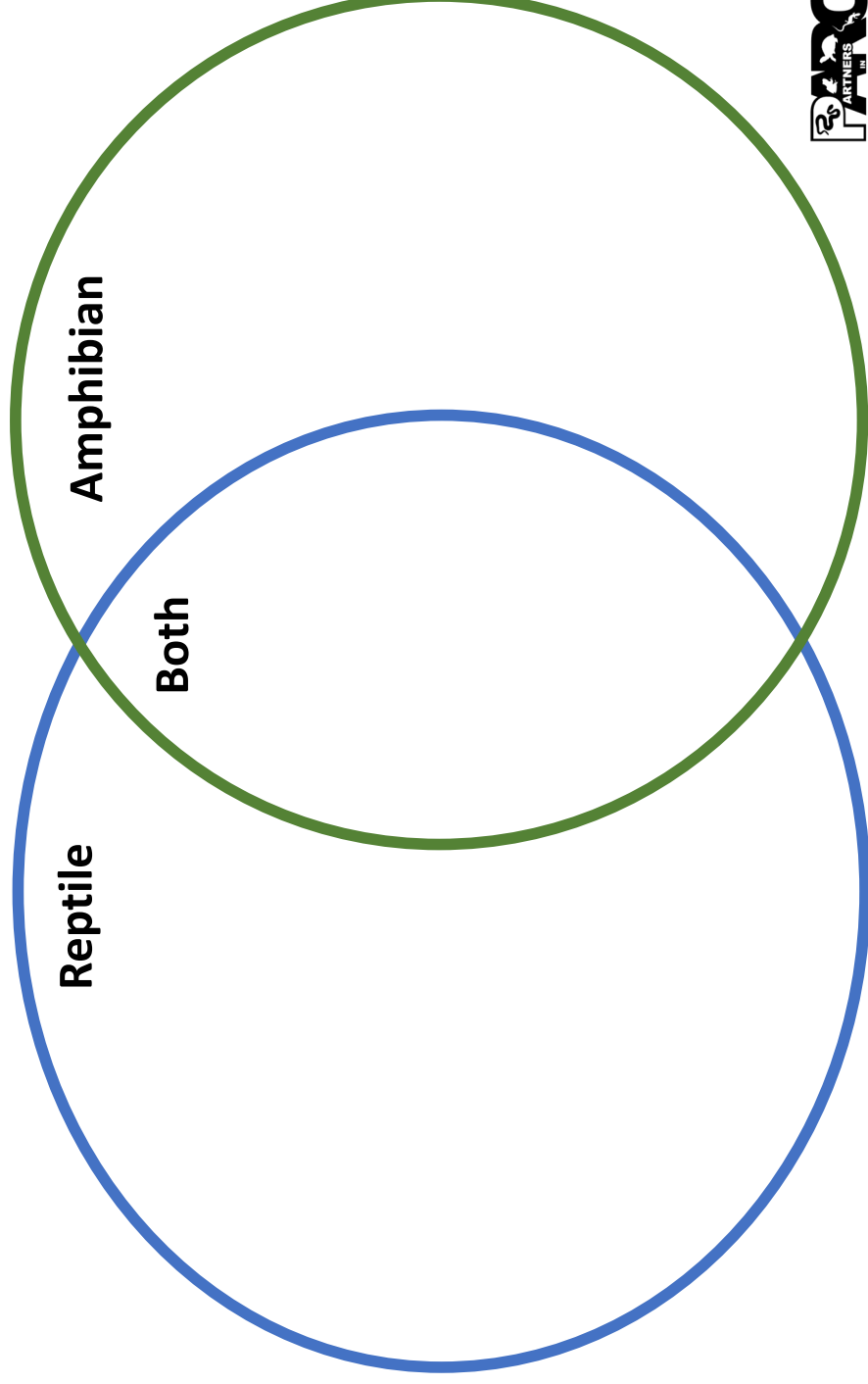

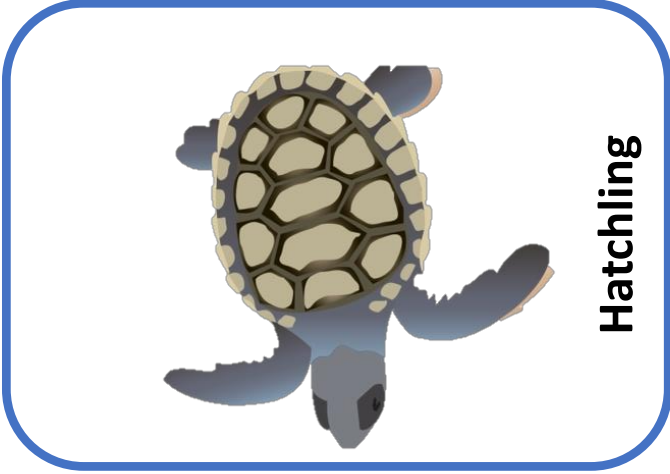
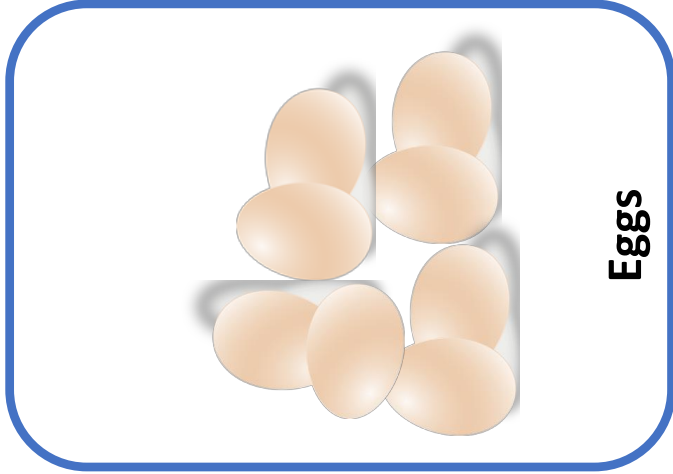
Cool Turtle Spotlight

- The **snapping turtle** spends most of its time in water.
- This turtle typically weigh up to 35 lbs as an adult, but largest recorded snapping turtle was 86 lbs!
- Snapping turtles are mostly solitary, but they will communicate with leg movements as they face each other.

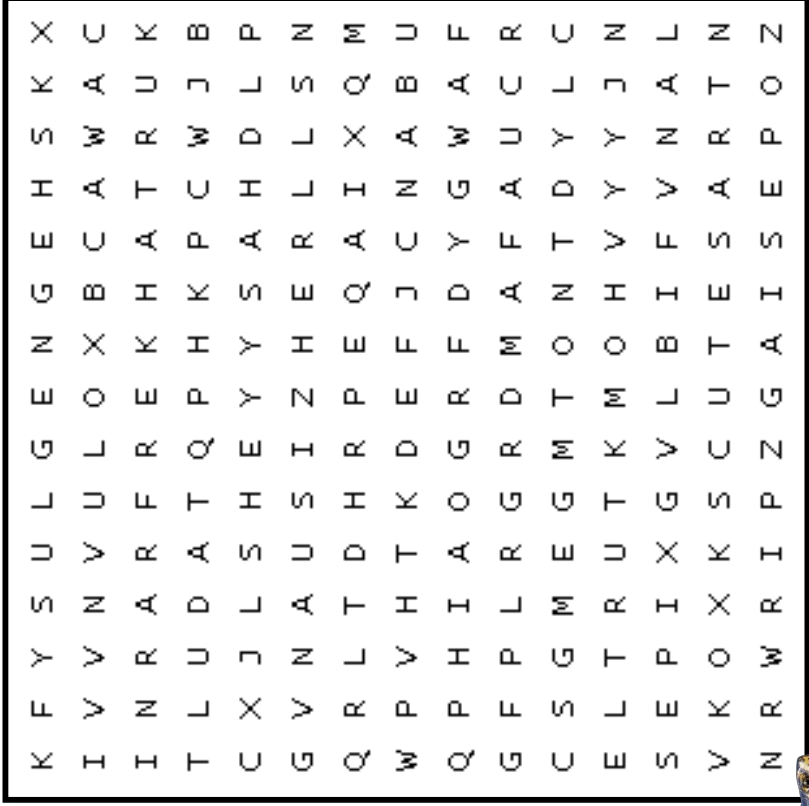

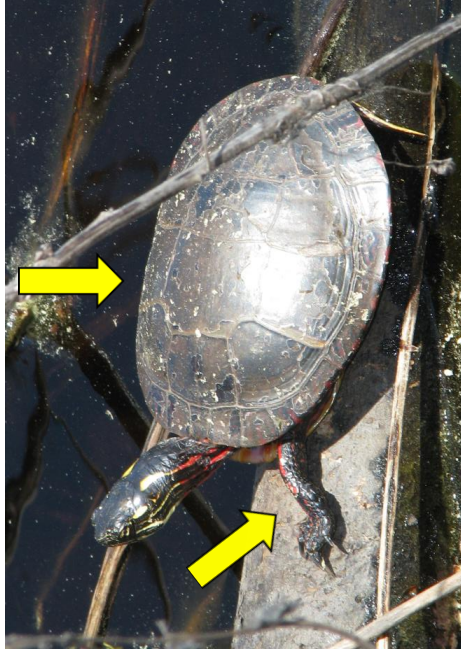
Turtle or a Tortoise?!



Did you know? Tortoises are turtles, but *not* all turtles are tortoises. tortoises spend most of their time on land and turtles spend most of their time in water.

Turtle

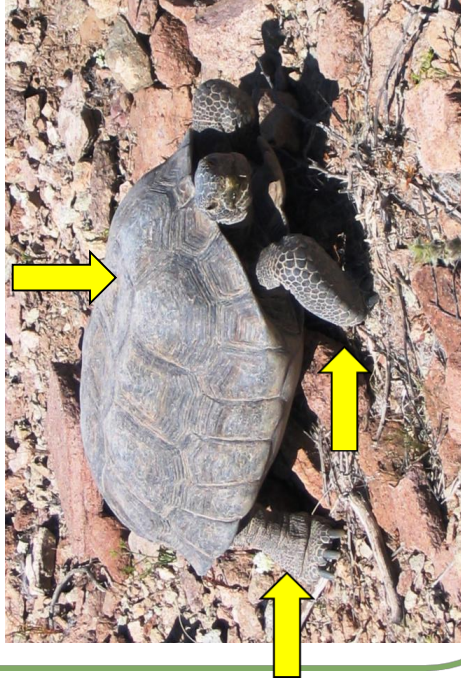
- Streamlined shell
- Often have webbed feet and flipper-like legs

- Have club-like front legs and elephant-like back legs.

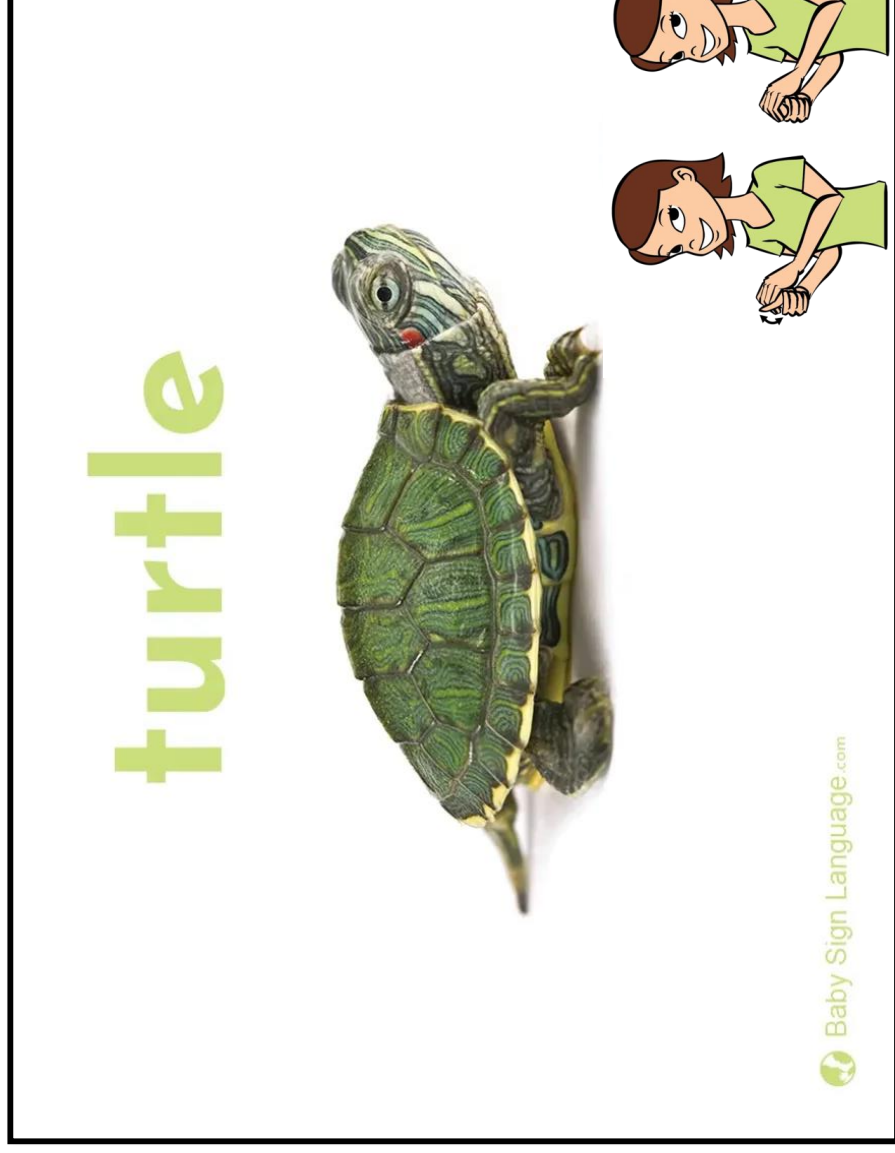


Cool Turtle Spotlight



- **Desert Tortoises** can escape the heat by burrowing underground.
- They can go long periods of time without water and can store water in their bladder!
- Desert Tortoises eat plants like grasses, flowers, some cacti, and fruit.
- They are only found in the Mojave Desert in California, Nevada, Arizona, and Utah

Turtle-Friendly Backyards

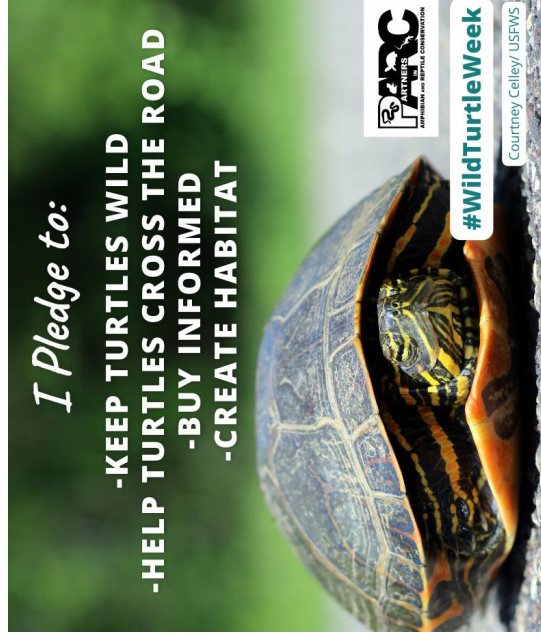
Follow these steps to make your backyard welcoming to turtles:
